

BC Registration Info – Summer 2018

All students are required to register for: MUSC B28 Drum & Bugle Corps, CRN 50519

- You **MUST** register for this BC class **or you will not be allowed to participate.**

Returning BC Students:

New Students (including CSUB, HS, etc.) attending BC for the first time:

You will need to complete some of the matriculation [steps](#).

1. Create a CCCApply account and apply for BC at <https://www.bakersfieldcollege.edu/apply>
2. **Check your email!!!!** Activate your application using the link that is emailed to you.
3. You should receive a BC ID # that looks like @00123456. Send that number to theasley@bakersfieldcollege.edu
4. Stay tuned for info on a one-day matriculation workshop that will be offered this semester.

Current High School Students:

You will need to apply for concurrent enrollment **each** semester at BC in order to register for the course:

1. Schedule an appointment and meet with **your** HS counselor.
2. **FULLY** complete an *Application for Concurrent Enrollment Form*
 - a. Get this from your HS counselor or email theasley@bakersfieldcollege.edu
 - b. **Do NOT** lose this once it has been completed and signed!
3. Turn this form into Tim Heasley at the next rehearsal, or...

HS Students from out of town:

- You can scan or send a hi-quality picture of your completed *Application for Concurrent Enrollment Form* to theasley@bakersfieldcollege.edu
- If you are in the *system* (by completing the online application above) and have no other holds, Admissions will be able to manually add you to the course.

Audit info for BC students that have exceeded repeatability of the course or are out of state residents:

You should be able to audit the course in order to participate. Contact theasley@bakersfieldcollege.edu for a *Course Audit Form* and further details about the process.

BC Registration Fees (paid to Bakersfield College):
