Thank you for your interest in the Golden Empire Drum & Bugle Corps! This sheet will give you the information that you will need in order to be successful at guard auditions.

What to wear/bring for auditions:

- Form-fitting black athletic/work-out clothing
- Shoes you can dance in (No sandals or flip flops) We may be outside for a portion of the day, so please be prepared with the proper footwear.
- <u>If</u> you plan on auditioning for a weapon spot, you must bring your own riffle. Flags will be provided for all who attend.
- Water Jug
- OPEN MIND

What we are looking for in a prospective member:

- Good sense of timing and understanding of tempo
- Good dance and equipment technique You must display an understanding of the basics and the ability to learn skills you don't currently possess.
- Good performance quality –This means that you must have the ability to convey the character and emotion required to physically represent the musical themes.
- Positive attitude towards the work required as well as other members
- Ability to adapt and learn quickly
- Responsibility
- Strong work ethic

Your position in this group will be evaluated based on your abilities, but more importantly we are looking for individuals who have a strong ability to learn new skills and material in a timely fashion. We are looking for members who are motivated, ready to learn, work hard, and have an open mind to everything the activity may entail.
